ARTICLES OF INCORPORATION
OF
WONDERLAND PARENT COOPERATIVE
PRESCHOOL FOR RETARDED CHILDREN

We, the undersigned persons, acting as the incorporators of a corporation under the provisions of the Washington Non-Profit Corporations Act (RCW 24.03), adopt the following Articles of Incorporation for such corporation:

ARTICLE I

The name of the corporation shall be WONDERLAND PARENT COOPERATIVE PRESCHOOL FOR RETARDED CHILDREN.

ARTICLE II

The period of duration of the corporation shall be perpetual.

ARTICLE III

The purposes for which the corporation is organized are:

1. To constitute a non-profit, benevolent and charitable corporation under the Non-Profit Corporation Laws of the State of Washington.
2. To promote the education, training, recreation, social, progress, and general welfare of mentally retarded children.
3. To provide partial care as required, wherever possible, when the existing state institutional facilities are unable to accommodate mentally retarded, brain damaged, emotionally disturbed children or those unacceptable to public schools, and/or any handicapped child whose care is not otherwise

provided for.

4. To exchange and share the resources of personal information and experience in order to effectively meet the needs of the brain damaged, mentally retarded or otherwise handicapped children.

5. Generally, to exercise all the powers granted to corporations under the laws of the State of Washington relating to non-profit corporations in order to carry out the objects and purposes of this corporation.

ARTICLE IV

The corporation shall have no capital stock and shall have one class of members. The qualifications of members shall be as are set forth in the bylaws.

There shall be a Board of Trustees of not less than five members nor more than fifteen, the exact number to be established by the bylaws. The Board of Trustees shall elect from its number a president, vice president, secretary and treasurer, together with such other officers as the membership may from time to time designate in the bylaws. The officers of the Board of Trustees shall be elected at the annual meeting of the membership of the corporation.

ARTICLE V

The address of the initial registered office of the corporation shall be 20128 53rd Avenue N.E., Seattle, King County, Washington. The name of the initial registered agent of the corporation at such address shall be James Goff.

ARTICLE VI

The number of trustees constituting the initial Board of Trustees of the corporation shall be eleven. The names and addresses of the persons who are to serve as the initial
